(b) Tell us what you're bringing to the pot-luck (appetizer or dessert to go with Sloppy Joes).

2. Be at Vicki and Quentin's home starting line at 4PM on Saturday, April 26 for detailed instructions.

(a) Bring a cell phone with e-mail capacity.

You'll be e-mailing pictures back to Vicki and Quentin.

(b) Bring your pot luck item.

(c) Bring \$10 per car to buy some items listed in the rally instructions.

3. More than 1 couple to a car: Plan on having another person or another couple jump in the car to follow the route together. It's social.

4. How to:

a. Participants will be given a list of instructions and directions about where to go and how to prove you were there.

b. Points are awarded for finishing in a timely manner and for each item brought back.

c. The rally should take 1 to 1 1/2 hours.

The route finishes at Vicki and Quentin's house.

d. Turn in what you've collected to Vicki and Quentin or their designees. They will assign points and determine the winners.

e. Prizes will be given in categories such as:
